ALL CANDIDATES ARE REQUIRED TO FILE A CF-1 CAMPAIGN

FINANCE REGISTRATION STATEMENT even if they do not intend to spend or raise money for their campaign. Each candidate and current office-holder must have a committee. The committee name may be the candidates name "Joey Boone" or "Friends of Joey Boone for County Board" or anything similar. The local filing officer (County Clerk) collects the registration form, files it, and makes it available for public inspection.

Before a candidate raises or spends (even their own money) on the campaign a CF-1 Campaign Finance Registration Statement must be on file with the filing officer (County Clerk).

All sections must be completed and filed with the filing officer (County Clerk) no later than 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, January 2, 2024 for the Spring Election.

- 1. New Candidates choose "NO" Continuing Candidates choose "YES"
- **A1.** Name to be used for campaign attributions, disclaimers and contributions.
- **A8.** Bank information must be completed even when claiming exempt or no intent to raise or spend money. Institution Name can be an account specifically for the campaign or it may be the candidates personal banking information.
- **A13.** If the committee has a Treasurer this information should be completed. If there is no Treasurer, candidate will indicate "Self" or "Candidate" and leave the rest of this section blank.

Filing Exemption This is an aggregate amount, including receiving contributions, making disbursements, or incurring obligations in an aggregate amount exceeding \$2,500 in a calendar year.

Example: In a calendar year, if you raise \$1600 and spend \$1000 you have \$2,600 of aggregate activity and are not eligible to claim exemption.

January 1 begins a new calendar year. Unless the candidate is 100% sure they will exceed the \$2,500, they may want to file exempt. If they exceed the limit, they must file an amendment within 10 days or of knowing to update their status. It is easier to go from Exempt to Non-Exempt, then it is from Non-Exempt to Exempt.

- **A28.** One of the boxes MUST be marked. The candidate should keep records of contributions and disbursements even if they claim Exempt status.
- **B1.** This is to include the County and District #. See example.
- **B3.** Election date is always the general election date, never use a primary date.
- **B4.** The name listed should be the name that will be on the ballot as indicated on the Declaration of Candidacy and the Nomination Paper Header.
- **B11.** One of the boxes must be marked
- **B12.** Should only be completed if the answer to B11 is "No."

Candidates must complete all sections A, B, and C.

- Item 1. Is this an amendment? Have you registered with this local clerk to run for office in a prior election?
- Item A1: Committee Name. All candidates are required to register a committee. It is not required that the name include the candidate's name, but it is recommended. This committee name is required to be part of the disclaimer on all communications with express advocacy: 'Paid for by ...'
- A28: Exemption. Candidates claiming exemption may not have more than \$2,500 of activity, in the aggregate per year. In a calendar year, if you raise \$1,600 and spend \$1,000 you have \$2,600 of aggregate activity and are not eligible to claim exemption.

Depository Institution Information. All candidates must designate a depository institution. While it is recommended that all candidates have a designated campaign depository account, candidates who will serve as their own treasurer may designate a single personal account to serve as the committee depository account while claiming a filing exemption and may intermingle personal and campaign funds (Wis. Stat. § 11.0201(2)(b)).

Treasurer Information. Each committee must appoint a treasurer. Any adult may serve as a treasurer. A candidate may serve as his or her own treasurer. If you are serving as your own treasurer, please write "Self" or "Candidate." A candi-date serving as their own treasurer does not need to provide their name, address and contact information here because that information will already be provided in section B.

Section B: Candidate Information

- B1. Be sure to include the name of the county, municipality, or school district. There are 72 counties with county supervisors, 100's of school boards, and 1000's of municipal boards.
- B2. Party "N/A" or "None" for nonpartisan offices (April). Democrat, Republican, Constitution, Green, Independent, or other ballot status party for partisan (fall) primary/election.

Section C: Certification. All candidates must complete section C. If the candidate is serving as their own treasurer, they would only need to sign once, as either the candidate or treasurer.
